Director's Notes

This is Trinity's seventh pantomime since we revived the tradition in 2010 and we have chosen Jack and the Beanstalk – a classic tale of poverty and wealth, love and adversary, good and evil and lashings of boos and cheers.

The famous English folktale 'Jack and the Beanstalk' was first written in 1807 however strands of the story are embedded in British folklore and certainly predate the 19th Century. There are references to 'Fie Foh and Fum, I smell the blood of a British man' in Shakespeare's King Lear from the 17th century. And even earlier, there are references to trees, vines and cucumbers (..?) connecting heaven and earth in ancient Nordic and Celtic traditions as well as similar references in the Bible and Renaissance art. The Pantomime interpretation of this yarn is only a contemporary interpretation of this enduring tale.

As my first meander into the director's chair, I'm proud to be a part of this production which brings new and young performers together alongside veterans of the stage in a truly unique theatrical experience. It would not have been possible without the help of a remarkable, dedicated and talented Production Team mentioned in this programme.

Sit back, enjoy, sing-along, boo and laugh out loud. It's infectious. We really couldn't do this without you.
